Greetings of peace!

To further enrich our knowledge base of our students' reading skills, the Assumption Antipolo Elementary English Department has once more availed of the **i-Ready Diagnostic** assessment for this school year. The **i-Ready Diagnostic** is a computer-based, adaptive form of assessment which measures students' skills in specific Reading domains. This assessment is individualized because it is designed to dynamically select test items based on student response patterns. The diagnostic test does not consider the age of the student, but only her current grade level and its consequent target reading level. The results of the **i-Ready** test help our Reading teachers, as well as the parents of our students, better monitor and help develop our students' reading skills.

Please find attached your daughter's **i-Ready** Pretest results. Kindly note that though the **i-Ready Diagnostic** is part of our Elementary English instruction, the test results are not part of your daughter's grade in English. At the end of the school year, we will again furnish you a copy of your daughter's **i-Ready** Posttest results so you can track her reading development.

For your guidance, please see the definition of each Reading domain below:

<b>Phonological Awareness</b> This domain is focused on how children distinguish the sounds (or phonemes) in spoken words
<b>Phonics</b> This domain focuses on how accurately children decode written words. Decoding refers to matching a letter or combination of letters (graphemes) to their sounds (phonemes) and recognizing the patterns that make syllables and words.
<b>High-Frequency Words</b> This domain addresses how well children recognize frequently occurring words.
<b>Vocabulary</b> Both word knowledge and word-learning strategies are addressed in this domain.
<b>Comprehension: Literature</b> This domain addresses understanding of literary text (Ex. poetry, plays, fairy tales, fables, folktales, myths, etc).
<b>Comprehension: Informational Text</b> This domain addresses understanding of nonfiction or expository text. This includes ability to retell facts and information.

We hope you will find the **i-Ready** test results informative and helpful. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to consult your daughter's English teacher.
