Greetings of Peace! Please be reminded of the following for Moving-up Day:

- I. All students and parents are expected to be in school by 7:30 a.m. Parents will proceed to the Assumpta Theater following the color-coded tickets attached to the program – yellow for left orchestra and blue for right orchestra.
