Greetings of Peace! Please be reminded of the following for graduation:



- I. All students and parents are expected to be in school by 7:30 a.m. Parents will proceed to the Assumpta Theater following the color-coded tickets attached to the program – yellow for left orchestra and blue for right orchestra. Balcony 1 will be open for guests. **Children below 7 years old are not allowed.** Students will assemble at the Grade 6 classrooms.
- II. Attire for parents and other guests is **strictly formal**.
