Pls. review the following concepts and practice the following skills (STE 4):

I. LANGUAGE ARTS

- Identifies letter name and sound of Ss, Aa, Tt, Ii, Pp, Nn, Cc, Ee, Hh, Rr, Mm, Dd, and Gg.
- Identifies pictures and their beginning letter.
- Repeats nursery rhymes and songs
- Listens to and tries to recall some parts of a story.
- Uses speech as means of communicating ideas and feelings.

II. WRITING

- Writes upper and lower case of letters: Ss, Aa, Tt, Ii, Pp, Nn, Cc, Ee, Hh, Rr, Mm, Dd, and Gg.
- Traces and draws basic shapes.
- Traces and writes lines: up and down, left to right, slanting, curve
- Copies and writes her first name properly.
- Traces simple figures

III. MATH AND SCIENCE CONCEPTS

- Counts by rote (1 – 10)
- Describes how plants grow (seed, small plant, big tree, big tree with flowers or fruits)
- Identifies plant needs (soil, sunlight, water, love)
- Recognizes and identifies basic shapes: circle, square, triangle, rectangle, square
- Recognizes and identifies secondary shapes: diamond, oval, star, heart
- Identifies big and small, tall and short, long and short, in and out

IV. SOCIAL LIVING

- Names and identifies the different community helpers:
 - who teach us: teacher, priest, nun
 - who prepare our food: baker, farmer
 - who look after our health: doctor, nurse, dentist, vet
 - who keep us safe: police, guard, firefighter

V. PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- **FINE MOTOR SKILLS**
 - Uses scissors with ease (one snip)
 - Holds pencil, crayons, and paintbrush using the tripod grip
 - Picks up small objects using the thumb and pointer grip
 - Manipulates self – help materials (zipper, buttons, snaps)
 - Colors and paints pictures evenly and within the lines
- **GROSS MOTOR SKILLS**
 - Walks, marches, and runs properly
 - Jumps over two objects, landing on both feet
 - Jumps and reaches for an object overhead
 - Steps on mats alternately
 - Climbs up and goes down the stairs using alternating feet

- Practice speaking clearly in complete sentences.
- Practice tracing, writing, drawing, painting, and coloring using the tripod grip
- Practice cutting straight lines.
