## **Dear Parents and Guardians:**

Good day! In the Circular to Parents dated January 31, 2020, the School Doctor gave an overview of the 2019-nCoV and discussed steps to take towards preventing the spread of the virus.

Measures Put in Place by the School. The School continues to recommend that students and employees come to school in surgical or cloth masks, wash hands with soap and water regularly, and stay home if they have a cough, cold, or fever. Alcohol bottles with pump dispensers have been placed in classrooms, washrooms, and other common areas, and students and employees have been instructed to sanitize their hands regularly. Doorknobs, desks, and other surfaces are regularly disinfected.

Students and Employees Coming Back from Trips. The Department of Health (DOH) Secretary, chairperson of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases in the Philippines (IATF-EID), mandates a fourteen (14) day quarantine for Filipinos coming from any place in China and its Special Administrative Regions (i.e. Hongkong and Macau).

Educational Trips. The Department of Education mandates the suspension of all off-campus activities for February 2020 (DepEd Memorandum No.015, s. 2020), thus all field trips and off-campus activities (e.g. AKK, Work Immersion) have been suspended. The Academic team is looking into rescheduling these field trips\*. Information regarding possible rescheduling will be communicated to students and parents when they are finalized.

\*The Grade 1 Field Trip has been cancelled. An alternative activity will be provided (CIR released on February 6, 2020).
