Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we expect more rains to come, we also anticipate incidences of Dengue fever in our communities. As the school has been doing every year as a precautionary measure against Dengue, we would like to inform you that your daughters may now come to school in proper Dengue attire. It consists of white long-sleeved shirt with a school patch on the left chest and PE jogging pants or any dark-colored jogging pants for uniformity and adequate coverage. The white long-sleeved shirts are available in the school bookstore. A pair of socks, preferably long, is also advised to be worn.

Please take note that if your child is suffering from fever of 2 days or more and experiencing any of the following signs and symptoms below, it is highly recommended that you bring her to her doctor immediately for further assessment and management.

- headache
- body weakness
- joint and muscle pains
- loss of appetite
- abdominal pain
- vomiting
- flushed/reddened skin; rashes
- bleeding

The school continuously does its part in eliminating possible breeding sites for mosquitoes that transmit Dengue fever disease and in maintaining cleanliness of its surroundings. We are also encouraging everyone to practice the same measures in preventing Dengue infection.
