B. Work Hours

D. Transportation

The parents and guardians are expected to arrange for the transportation of the students. The students are advised to consider carpooling with other students assigned to the same institution. (Consider offering gas money if carpooling.)

E. Food

The students are required to bring packed lunch and snacks in a lunch bag on the first day. In the next days, they may buy from the office cafeteria. They are not allowed to buy food outside unless there is no food sold in the building.

F. Work Etiquette

The students should always observe basic office etiquette. (Please refer to section VII of the Work Immersion

G. Fieldwork

The partner institutions should secure the written consent of parents or guardians for fieldwork. The school should be informed of the nature of activity, date of activity, and chaperone(s) for students. No student will be allowed to participate in any activity outside the work immersion venue without parental permission.

H. Student Discipline

The Code of Discipline of the school is in effect in the partner institution venue. Students are subject to disciplinary measures of the school in the event that the Partner Institution Supervisor reports mishehavior.

I. Insurance

Since Work Immersion is an official school activity, the students are covered by the insurance provided by the school. The students are reminded to be careful and to strictly follow rules and regulations in order to avoid any untoward incident.

J. School Supervision

The students will be visited by members of the school's Work Immersion Team to check on their participation and to meet and to thank the Partner Institution Supervisor.

K. Student's Kit

The students are required to bring a brown envelope that contains the following: (1) consent form (to be given to the Partner Institution), (2) resume, (3) cover letter, (4) daily activity log, (5) consent and waiver form for fieldwork, (6) student evaluation form, (7) notebook, and (8) pen. This will be checked on February 4, 2020.

Please help us prepare your daughter for Work Immersion by checking on her readiness and reminding her to get all the information she needs. This activity is going to be a very enriching experience for students. We look forward to listening to their sharing of their insights and learning.
