Greetings!

The Grade 9 students will have their Stargazing Activity at the Assumption Antipolo Football Field from 4:00 PM of February 14 (Friday) to 6:00 AM of February 15, 2020 (Saturday).

The Stargazing Activity aims to engage students in becoming young astronomers by acquiring facts about the solar system and heavenly bodies while recognizing the important contributions of astronomy to everyday life. This is also a chance for them to strengthen their interpersonal skills and deepen their appreciation for all of God's creation as they learn about objects beyond Earth.

A fee of Php 400.00, which was included in the Grade 9 tuition, was collected from each student. This amount will cover all expenses such as their dinner on February 14, the resource speaker's fee, and other miscellaneous expenses.

The students are encouraged to bring their smart phones with the application "SkyView Lite" installed. This will be used to help the students visualize and locate stars, satellites, and constellations. However, proper procedures and handling of the gadget must be observed. During the day, the phone must be turned off and kept inside their lockers. During the activity proper, the students should only use it as advised by the teacher and the resource speaker.

The following are the things that the students need to bring:


- ☐ Tents

- ☐ Personal toiletries, medications, clothes


The students will set-up their tents at the Football Field from 4:00 to 4:45 PM. For security reasons, the school will not allow food deliveries at any time.




