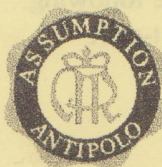

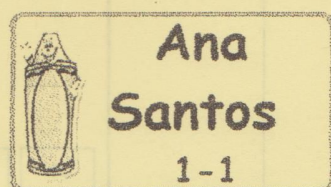

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to the Grade 1 Family!

Thank you for choosing Assumption and sharing with our mission to form and bring out the best in your CHILD. To facilitate her adjustment to Grade 1, please take note of the following guidelines:

1. During class hours, parents, guardians, caregivers, and drivers who wait for the children must stay in the waiting area located at the parking area near the Main Gate.
2. Parents who wish to consult with teachers may request for appointments through your child's assignment notebook. Kindly wait for the teacher's confirmation.
3. Students must come and leave school in complete uniform from Monday to Friday, except during P.E. days. The official I.D. and name tag must be worn at all times.
4. Prepare the name and transportation tag for your child. Please laminate and put a lace on the tag. Start wearing the name tag **on or before June 24, Monday.**

5. **We encourage simplicity.** Having birthday parties in school is discouraged. Wearing simple jewelry (such as a pair of stud earrings) and hair accessories in shades of red, black or white are allowed.
6. **Please label all the things and materials of your child.** These include books, notebooks, pencils, pencil case, folders, and other personal belongings in the grooming kit. The grooming kit may either be a kiddie shoe box or small bag that can fit in the locker (*size of locker: length=14 inches, width=10 inches, height=10 inches*). A locker will be provided for each child.

The grooming kit must contain the following:


- extra underwear, shorts, and t-shirt
- hand sanitizer
- insect repellent
- comb or hairbrush
- cologne or powder
- face towel and bath soap
- two rolls of tissue
- toothbrush and toothpaste
- eating utensils (reusable spoon, fork, plate and glass)
- eco-bag
- rag

The grooming kit should be brought to school on June 24, Monday.


7. Prepare healthy food just enough for your daughter to finish. Food and drinks for recess and lunch should be placed in reusable food containers to minimize trash. Cloth placemat should be included in their lunch bag every day.

9. Regularly check and sign your child's assignment notebook as well as CIR folder for circulars from the school. **Kindly return all reply slips within three days.**
10. Payment of fees sent through your child must be in the exact amount and placed in a sealed and properly labeled envelope (i.e. name, grade and section, payment for _____).
11. Students come to school in P.E. uniform on their scheduled P.E. day.
 During swimming class, students bring a separate bag for their swimming materials which include:

<i>AA Swimsuit</i>	<i>extra shirt (plain white shirt or Fellowship Shirt)</i>
<i>AA Swimming cap</i>	<i>extra underwear</i>
<i>goggles (optional)</i>	<i>slippers</i>
<i>towel</i>	<i>plastic bag</i>
<i>shampoo and soap</i>	

All swimming materials must be labeled.

12. All students are required to have a **GO bag**. It must contain the following:
 - 1/2 liter bottle of drinking water
 - 1 high energy snack (unsalted nuts, energy bar, granola)
 - one set change of underwear and clothes
 - family photo
 - bandage
 - Whistle with flashlight
 - personal medications (for those with special conditions)
 - Povidone Iodine (Betadine)
 - cotton
 - garbage bag

The GO bag should be brought to school on June 25, Tuesday.

Your cooperation and support will be of great help to us as we journey together in accompanying your child throughout the school year.

Let this be a fruitful and God-filled year for both the home and the school. We count on your enthusiasm in working with us.
