Part of the science curriculum of Assumption Antipolo is to provide experiences that will allow the students to appreciate nature and realize the importance of conserving and preserving our natural resources. In line with this objective, the Grade 10 students will have their BIOLOGY TRIP on February 21 and 22, 2019 (Thursday and Friday). The venue of the said trip will be at Adventure Beach Waterpark, Subic Bay, Zambales.

This is an interdisciplinary activity integrated with other subject areas like Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and Alay Kapwa at Kalikasan (AKK). A fee of Php 2, 700, which was included in the Grade 10 tuition, was collected from each student. This amount will cover all the expenses such as the bus fee, park entrance fee, and miscellaneous expenses.
