hairstyle (use white and black clips only)

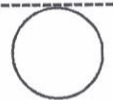

3. **PICTURE-TAKING**

The school's official photographer is the only one allowed to take pictures during the Mass. Special arrangements may be made with the photographer for additional solo pictures or family pictures (this is not covered by the Communion fee).

4. **SEATS**

To ensure order, we have assigned specific seats for you, which are labeled accordingly. Your daughter's First Holy Communion banner will be hung to mark your seat. A seat plan will be given for your guidance.

Due to limited space, only the parents or any two guardians can be accommodated. Bringing of babies and children below 7 years old is greatly discouraged.

5. **COMMUNION**

Please accompany your daughter to the altar for her First Holy Communion, **with the father at the right and the mother at the left**. Put your hands on her shoulders as she receives Communion. Parents, teachers, staff, and guests may receive Communion from the Eucharistic Lay Ministers on either side.


6. **CERTIFICATES**


We hope to make this celebration a very memorable one for our girls. Thank you very much for your support. May the good Lord continue to shower you with His abundant blessings of peace and joy.
