- 1. The Rite of Confirmation is scheduled on SATURDAY, JANUARY 26, 2019. It will be held at the MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING. The Holy Eucharist will start at 8:00 a.m., and it will be presided by Rev. Fr. Edwin Soliva, SDB, and the Sacrament of Confirmation will be administered by Monsignor Rigoberto de Guzman.
- 2. All students, parents, and godparents are expected to come at 7:00 a.m. for registration and settling down. We advise you to take breakfast prior to the celebration.

3. ATTIRE

- 1. Student:

 - Hair appropriately styled and kept away from the forehead, and only black or white hair accessories
 - NO make-up
 - NO jewelry except for a formal watch and simple stud earrings

- 2. Parents and Godparents Formal Attire

4. PICTURE - TAKING

The school's official photographer is the only one allowed to take pictures or video during the Holy Mass. Special arrangements may be made with the photographer for additional solo pictures or family pictures. This is not covered by the Confirmation fee.

5. SEATING ARRANGEMENT

To ensure order, we have assigned specific seats for you. Please look for your daughter's name on the seat. Due to limited space, only the parents and godparents can be accommodated. To help maintain a prayerful atmosphere, please do not bring babies and children below 7 years old to the event.

6. CONFIRMATION CEREMONY

During the Confirmation Rite, the godparents must accompany the confirmand as she walks down the aisle to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Parents should stay in their seats.

7. All cellular phones and other electronic devices must be **turned off** during the entire ceremony.
