The Grade 9 students will be having their Educational Trip at GMA Network Center, Quezon City Experience (QCX), and Art in Island on February 6 (Wednesday) from 5:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

GMA Network is one of the major national commercial broadcast television and radio networks in the Philippines. The company provides television studios and radio stations tours that provide tour participants an overview of the network's operation and production and an opportunity to interact with selected personalities from their News and Current Public Affairs department.

Art in Island, Inc. is one of the biggest interactive art museums in South East Asia. It houses over 50 visually stunning 3D artworks with varied themes, which guests can touch, interact with, and be a part of.

The Quezon City Experience (QCX) is an interactive museum that houses fifteen (15) galleries that allow guests to virtually live the rich and colorful history, culture, art, and everyday life and times of the city that former president Manuel L. Quezon had built.

The objectives of the activity are to expand our students' concept of literacy to acknowledge the worlds of print, visual, audio, and interactive media, to promote their awareness of the importance of broadcast communication and journalism in providing them with information necessary in making the possible decisions concerning their lives, communities, societies, and governments, to strengthen their understanding of the value and benefits of art, particularly as an effective means of self-expression and meaning, to enhance their understanding of the realities in our society and communities in order to catalyze positive transformation, and to inspire them to emulate patriotic acts of former nation leaders so as to the same in their own communities.


C. Attire: batch shirt, jeans, and rubber shoes/sneakers


