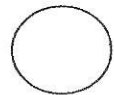
We invite you to help prepare your daughter for the retreat by discussing with her its meaning and importance and how it can help her live her life joyfully and meaningfully.


