Dear Preschool Parents and Guardians,

Greeting of JOY!

As part of the Assumption Antipolo Community, the Preschool Department invites your family to live out the school thrust, *Reclaim our JOY as God's beloved!*, through our annual **FAMILY PROJECT**. This year's project comes in three parts: Part1-Family Reflection; Part 2-Joy Campaign; Part 3-A Picture of Joy.

Part 1: Family Reflection

Begin your family meeting with a prayer. Now, we invite your family to reflect on and talk about what **joy** means to each family member. Here are some guide questions to help you:

1. *What does "joy" mean? (Focus on the joy of being loved by God through family and friends.)*
2. *What makes you joyful? (Let each family member mention one example.)*
3. *How can you bring joy to others? (Emphasize "Enjoying simple things with others")*

Part 2: Joy Campaign

After your meaningful discussion, we invite your whole family to take part in the *Joy Campaign*. Below are the mechanics of this special assignment:

1. **Joy Calendar:** With the whole family, plot on the Joy Calendar the activities that bring joy to each family member. Remember to focus on simple things that do not require you to spend. Start the campaign as soon as possible.
2. **Family Time:** The campaign is as simple as spending time with the family to do what makes each member joyful. It can be time spent together *playing games, dancing to music, painting a picture, reading a good book, preparing a meal, or watching a fun video*. It can be any activity that makes you feel true joy.
3. **Pay it Forward:** After spending time with the family, go back to your Joy Calendar and plot one project your family can do to bring joy to people outside the family. Again, focus on simple things that will require minimal to no cost. Here are some suggested projects: *donating pre-loved items, sharing your talents, volunteering in a socio-civic group, engaging in an advocacy, or writing letters/making artworks for hospital patients*.

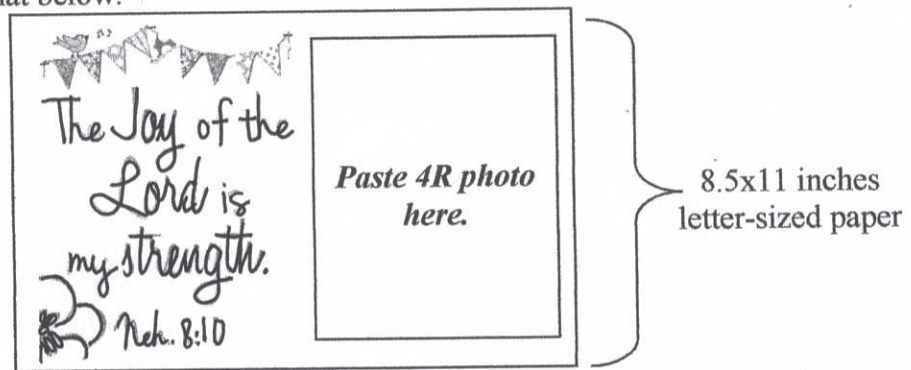

Part 3: A Picture of Joy

Lastly, we ask your family to make A Picture of Joy. Follow these easy steps:

1. Choose one photo of your family doing the Joy Campaign.
2. Print a 4R copy of your chosen photo(4x6inches).
3. On a letter-sized sheet of paper (8.5x11 inches), paste the 4R photo.
4. Beside the photo, write a quote or Bible passage about joy that will remind your family to live out our school thrust, **Reclaim our JOY as God's beloved!** The quote may be your original text or from another author. Remember to indicate the source of your quotation to give proper credit. Please follow the format below:



5. Decorate your project. Be as artistic as you can. Use colorful stickers, markers, paints, crayons, and other art materials to make it extra special.
6. Lastly, please mount your Picture of Joy in a sturdy picture frame with glass. This will be exhibited during Preschool Week.

Please submit your *Joy Calendar and A Picture of Joy* on or before **October 12, 2018**; your daughter will present these in class.

Thank you for your continuous support and cooperation. May this meaningful assignment be an opportunity for you and your family to live out the school thrust and spread the JOY of being God's beloved.
